




- To grow recreational Para Hockey (II) from 9 European nations to 24 nations across a minimum 3 continents

Category: Mental: Individual Difficulty: Under 12s

Description

ParaHockey (ID) Shooting Classification piolt test

Screen 1

TEST: The players ability to shoot accurately under time pressure.

ParaHockey (ID) Shooting Classification test

Each player has 1 minute

Player starts at Gate A and dribbles ball diagonally through Gate B before shootting at goal

Player then runs to Gate B, collects the next ball,runs diagonally through Gate A before shot at goal

- 3 points for shots entering the corner of the goal
- 2 points for shots entering the centre of the goal
- 1 point for shots 1 metre wide of the goal (tip in chance)

Kit needed to set up and manage:

- 1.8 marker cones
- 2, 20 balls
- 3. 1 ideally 2 or 3 supervisors









ParaHockey (ID) Dribbling classification test Category: Mental: Individual Difficulty: Senior

Pro-Club: European Hockey Federation Norman Hughes, Dewsbury, United Kingdom

Description

ParaHockey dribbling test

TEST: The players ability to dodge and move to space whilst retaining control of the ball.

Player starts at cone A runs straight down to cone B before weaving in and out of central cones C

Then player drops down to cone D runs up to cone E before running across to the start position

Each player has 1 minute and scores 2 pts for passing each cone correctly

So 2 pts for moving from Gate A

2 pts for moving past and around Gate B

2 pts for each of Gates at C (8 pts in the central area

2 points for passing around Gate D

2 points for moving around Gate E to the start

So each correct circuit scores 16 points

Each player has 1 minute.

Kit Needed:

- 1.8 cones
- 2. 1 ball
- 3. Ideally 2 supervisors.
